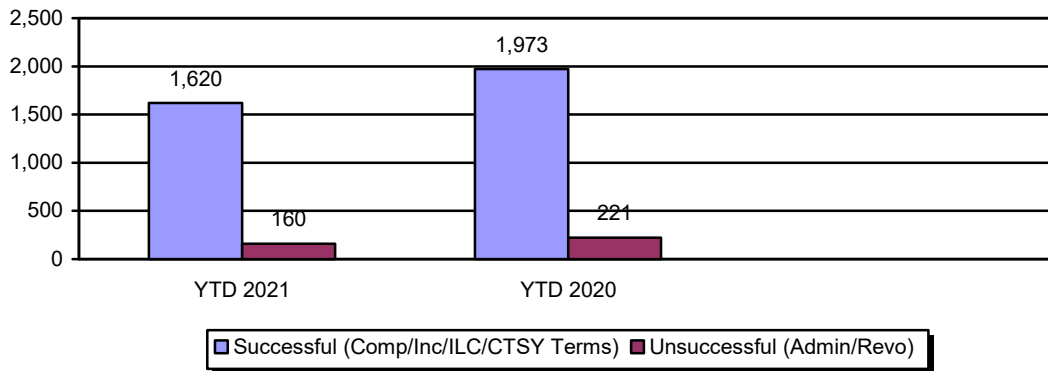

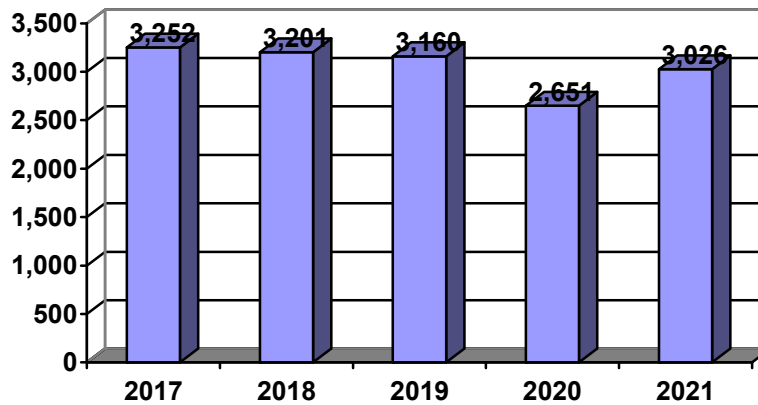

From January 6th to the 9th, Terri Hawk and Christina Peters attended the ACA Winter Conference in Phoenix, AZ. There they received our *Accreditation in recognition of the attainment of excellence in the operation of an Adult Probation and Parole Authority* for the period of 2022 to 2025. We have been accredited by the American Correctional Association Commission on Accreditation for Corrections since 1987 (Renewal required every 3 years). In 2003 we were the first agency in the United States to be accredited under the latest edition (4th) Performance Based Standards for adult probation and parole programs.
